

## Outer Planter Project Plans

An easy to build outdoor planter is a perfect project for your new Bora QuickCut™ cutting and measuring guide.

## **Materials Needed:**

- 1 Bora QuickCut™
- 1 Pencil
- 1 Tape Measurer
- **8** 2"x2"x 8' #1 Pressure Treated Lumber (Number of lengths dependent on the number of levels you wish to build. Our materials are based on a 6-level planter)
- 1 16oz Bottle of Water Proof Interior/Exterior Wood Glue

Nail Gun and nails (May substitute (36) 2" wood screws instead of using a nail gun)

48 2" Wood Screws (84- 2" wood screws if using screws instead of nails for attaching the pieces together to build each level)

120-200 grit sandpaper

Wood putty

Optional: To enhance the look of your finished product we recommend staining or painting your planter.

## **Steps Required**

1. Cut your 8ft 2"x2" lumber into 13 ¾ " pieces using your QuickCut™, make sure to cut both ends at 60° using your QuickCut™ set at the 60° setting. Each level requires (6) 13 ¾" lengths so you will need to cut 36 pieces in order to complete your 6 level planter box.





2. After cutting the (36) 13 ¾" pieces for your planter, you will need to lock them together tightly using your water proof glue and nail gun (You can substitute nails for 2" wood screws). Add a drop of water proof glue on each end of the piece then align the edges and make sure there are no gaps between the components. Using the nail gun shoot one nail into end of each piece connecting them together. Build all 6 levels using the same technique described above.





3. Next you will need to lock all the levels together. Lay the second level to the base octagon, as shown below. Secure the top level to the bottom level using your 2" wood screws and glue. Use 8 screws on each level to ensure you have a firm connection between levels. Repeat this step for each of the 6 levels you are building.



4. Fill in any holes or dents using wood putty and let dry for 2-3 hours. After drying use your sand paper to smooth all the surfaces. Optional paint or stain all surfaces for the perfect finish.
